Open to any operator or vendor who implemented a sustainability program in 2024. Up to 1000 words explaining achievements. Up to three supporting documents or links allowed.

- * Best competitive fibre access network operator
 For providers of competitive fibre access services (not NBN core). Covers services such as
 Enterprise Ethernet and DC dark fibre. Up to 1000 words explaining 2024 achievements. Up
 to three supporting documents or links allowed.
- * Best longhaul fibre network operator
 For providers of inter-state or international fibre trunk services. Up to 1000 words describing 2024 achievements. Up to three supporting documents or links allowed.
- * Best retail provider

For resellers of mobile or fixed telecom services. Up to 1000 words explaining 2024 achievements. Up to three supporting documents or links allowed.

- * Best fixed network initiative or partnership
 Open to fixed operators or vendors. May include partnerships or solo efforts. Covers
 breakthroughs, deployments or performance gains. Up to 1000 words and three supporting
 links/documents.
- * Best mobile network initiative or partnership
 Open to mobile operators or vendors. May include partnerships or solo efforts. Covers
 breakthroughs, deployments or performance gains. Up to 1000 words and three supporting
 links/documents.

* Best enterprise telco

Recognising providers of enterprise, business and government telecom services. Judged on innovation and customer testimonials. Up to three supporting documents or links allowed.

* Best wholesale telco

Recognising providers of wholesale services to other telcos. Judged on innovation and customer testimonials. Up to three supporting documents or links allowed.

* Hall of fame

Open to individuals with lifetime contributions to the Australian telecom sector. Nominations must come from someone other than the nominee. Up to 1000 words outlining the nominee's career. Finalists will be put to a judge vote.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT

After your nomination is submitted, it will be reviewed by a panel including current and former CommsDay editors and industry experts. Judging takes place in early May. Winners will be notified by late May to allow time to prepare for the mid-June ceremony.
